
To protect our planet, my family and I do a separate collection every day. We then divide the waste in the appropriate containers. We make a separate collection for paper, plastic and glass.

In addition, my parents buy only seasonal fruits and vegetables, and always Italian products; not only because the products exported from abroad pollute the environment, but also because they don't taste good.

To reduce plastic, I never buy plastic bottles, but I always bring my metal bottle with me.

We drink tap water, not bottled water. Some time ago my sister had to drink mineral water, not tap water: instead of taking water from plastic bottles, we used glass bottles.

We recycle all the clothes: all my clothes have always been given to my sister. Then my parents also bought her new clothes, but most of them were mine. Sometimes my sister's clothes are also donated to other poor children.
